Tour Boston and Cruise Canada 2012

Day One Friday, June 29, 2012

- 6:00am Board our Luxury Motorcoach and begin our day-long journey to Boston - we will be making Meal stops and Stretch Stops along the way.
- 5:00pm Arrive and **Check in** to our local hotel (**Springhill Marriott or similar**). Then we go and enjoy **dinner** this evening at the famous "**The Living Room**" restaurant of Boston.
- 7:30pm Visit the **Skywalk Observatory**, Boston's only sky-high vantage point for sweeping 360 degree views of Greater Boston and beyond.

Day Two Saturday, June 30, 2012

- 7:30am Enjoy a full **breakfast** this morning (and every morning while in Boston) at the hotel.
- 9:00am Meet your **GUIDE** and depart for your tour of the **Freedom Trail**. Begin your tour at the **State House** atop Beacon Hill. Walk through the **Boston Common**, American's oldest public park. Visit the **Old Granary Burial Ground**, Resting place of Paul Revere Sam Adams, John Hancock, the Boston Massacre Victims, and Mother Goose.
- 10:30am View the **Old South Meeting House (exterior only)**-No tax on tea! That was the decision on December 16, 1773, when 5,000 angry colonists gathered at the Old South Meeting House to protest a tax and started a revolution with the Boston Tea Party.
- 11:00am View the **Old State House (exterior only)**. The oldest surviving public building in Boston, it was built in 1713 to house the government offices. Stand on the Boston Massacre site where men lost their lives in an act of defiance.
- 11:30pm Enjoy **lunch and free time on your own** at **Faneuil Hall Market Place** known as **Quincy Market**.
- 1:00pm View the **Paul Revere House (exterior only)**. Visit the **Old North Church**. You will board and explore the oldest commissioned warship in the United States Navy, the **U.S.S. Constitution, "Old Ironsides"**!
- 7:15pm Enjoy **dinner** this evening at Boston's famous restaurant **Cheers**, "Where Everybody Knows Your Name!"

Day Three Sunday, July 01, 2012

- 9:00am After breakfast, meet our **guide** and depart on the **Liberty Ride**. Ride along the historic Battle Road while your costumed guide recounts the exciting events of April 19, 1775 and the literary legacy that defined American identity and culture at the Lexington Battle Green, where the Lexington militia confronted 800 British Regulars.
- 12:00pm Enjoy lunch on your own and some free time in the Shops at Prudential Center.
- 2:30pm Visit the **Kennedy Library Museum**. This museum portrays the life, leadership and legacy of President Kennedy, conveys his enthusiasm for politics and public service, and illustrates the nature of the office of the President
- 6:30pm Enjoy **dinner** this evening with an authentic **Lobster Bake** at **Gloucester House** of Boston.

Day Four Monday, July 02, 2012

- 10:00am After a leisurely breakfast, depart in our motorcoach for the Boston Seaport and our Cruise ship, the **Carnival Glory**.
- 12:30pm Check in and board the ship. Settle into your luxurious Outside Balcony Cabin the explore the ship a little before enjoying a delicious late lunch on the Lido deck. Mid-afternoon the ship leaves port and heads out to sea. This evening (and every evening) feast on a superb four course dinner in the ship's dining room then take in a live show in the grand ballroom or plays a little in the ship's full blown casino. Day Seven Thursday, July 05, 2012

- 9:00am Arrive at **Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada** - Hundreds of kilometers of incredible coastline with majestic scenery from end to end qualifies Halifax as perhaps one of the most beautiful capital cities in the world. There's plenty to see in Halifax. From picturesque fishing villages, to vibrant shopping districts. Not to mention impressive galleries and museums, historic sites, fine restaurants and colorful gardens.

Day Eight Friday, July 06, 2012

- all day Our second day at sea - go swimming in one of the many pools and hot tubs on this ship, try your luck at one of the largest casinos afloat, take in a comedy show at one of the showplaces aboard. There are many different fun contests throughout the day, craft classes, afternoon tea, art auctions, a full blown spa - no one should be bored while on this ship.

Day Nine Friday, July 07, 2012
